Policies such as:

- Grade Policies
- Grade Appeal
- Credit Hour
- Student Code of Conduct
- Student Code of Ethics
- Faculty Office Hours

#### Policies such as ...

- **Grade Policies** including possible Grades, Grading modes, Grade Appeal, Course retake, Academic Standing
- **Credit Hour** what exactly is a 3-credit course and what is the expected workload
- **Student Code of Conduct** Expectations of student behavior, selfdiscipline, and good judgement
- **Student Code of Ethics** Expectations of academic integrity
- Faculty Office Hours Reasonable access



#### **Grade Policies**

- Grades
  - Grade Change Form
  - Incomplete Grade Form
- Grading modes
- Grade Appeal
- Course retake
- Academic Standing





#### **Credit Hour**

- Typically15 weeks of instruction per semester.
- Each credit hour equals approximately **15 academic hours** of faculty-led instruction **plus** an additional **30 hours of out-of-class student work** per semester
- Approximately **3 hours per week**
- A three-credit course = 9 hours per week



# **Student Code of Conduct**

- Expectations of student behavior
- Student Code of Conduct Violation Report must be made in writing either to CodeofConduct@aua.am or via physical correspondence addressed to Provost, Student Code of Conduct.
- Standing Committee on Student Conduct and Ethics



# **Student Code of Ethics**

- Academic Misconduct Between a student and a course
- Faculty should seek advise of program chair and/or dean
- Oral warning; written warning; reduction in score in the academic evaluation involved or one of its components; retake of the academic evaluation involved or one of its components; failure in course
- Suspension; dismissal imposed by the Provost only
- Faculty: File a Violation of the Student Code of Ethics form



# **Faculty Office Hours**

Reasonable access, guidance, mentoring, faculty-student interaction

Teaching goes beyond the classroom. Faculty members are expected to provide students with **reasonable access** for questions and discussion – typically **two scheduled office hours** per 3-credit course [per week]. Office hours should include "by appointment" to accommodate students 'needs.



Office hours and contact information should be included on course syllabi.

# **Ethics and Grievance Committee**

- Non-anonymous written complaint
- Brought by **any member** of the University community
- Violation of
  - Faculty or Staff Code of Conduct
  - Statement on Academic Freedom
  - Equal Opportunity and Non-discrimination in Employment
