

FACULTY SENATE MISSION

The Faculty Senate of the American University of Armenia is an elected deliberative body whose primary purpose is to represent the AUA faculty to the University administration, to the Board of Trustees and to other parties as may be appropriate or necessary. The Faculty Senate Charter was approved by the Board of Trustees March 12, 2004 and states that the Faculty Senate shall be a representative body of all AUA faculty holding the ranks of Professor or Lecturer, including those faculty with Adjunct or Visiting status.

Charter

The Faculty Senate is vested with broad responsibility for deliberating and advising on University policies. The Faculty Senate is authorized to recommend to the President policies pertaining to courses, curriculum, and degree requirements, while the Board of Trustees retains final authority over the establishment of new degree programs. The Faculty Senate is further authorized to recommend to the President policies pertaining to student admissions and conduct and to advise on criteria for faculty appointments, standards of conduct, and welfare.
